4:00 PM Final - May be adjusted to coincide with relay times.

4:45 PM Awards.

It is recommended athletes be at the range a minimum of 45 minutes before the Call to the Line

ENTRIES: Entries for each equipment class, Sporter and Precision, will be limited to the first 76 Sporter Athletes and 76 Precision Athletes to sign up.

RULES: The current National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules will govern. The rule book may be downloaded from http://thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/Rules.pdf

COURSE OF FIRE: Sius Electronic Targets will be utilized.

QUALIFICATION: One course of 3x20 (20 prone, 20 standing, 20 kneeling)

FINAL: Top eight individuals, 10 shots standing

SCORING: Scores will be documented with the Sius Electronic Scoring System

PROTESTS: Protests of match conditions or individual shot values will incur a fee of \$1.00 for each protest and not exceed \$10.00 per athlete or coach.

SQUADDING: Four-person teams must be declared before the first sighting period of the match begins. All members of a team will be assigned to the same relay (except where team members are sharing equipment). This will allow teams to plan other activities before or after shooting.

SPECTATORS: Spectators are welcome to come and watch the match.

ENTRY DEADLINES: Sporter Entry Forms are due by February 10, 2024

Precision Entry Forms are due by February 17, 2024

ENTRY FEES: Individual entry fee is \$25.00.

Fees are payable at match day registration.

Make all checks payable to the Borealis Bullseyes Shooting Club.

AWARDS: EIC Points will be awarded

Individual: The top three individuals in Precision and in Sporter Classes will be awarded championship medals. All individuals will receive CMP certificates of participation.

Team: The top three teams in Precision and in Sporter Classes will be awarded championship medals.

The winning team and any team or individual above the minimum score in Sporter (2075 / 530) and Precision (2280 / 584) will qualify for the CMP National Championship. Invitations will not be passed down.

ELIGIBILITY:

Coaches: Each club or school team must have a designated coach to be responsible for their team. This person will be responsible for arranging travel for the teams and for team conduct while at the championship. Assistant coaches may attend.

Athletes: All athletes must comply with the "3.0 ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE" section of the National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules.

Rule 3.3: Athletes are not allowed to participate in both the sporter and precision classes.

Rule 3.2.6: No athlete may compete as a member of more than one team in one competition. .

Each club or school may send individuals and/or four-person team(s) plus an alternate athlete for Sporter and Precision Classes.

Membership: Athletes need not be a member of any other organization such as 4H, USA Shooting, NRA, or CMP.
